## Curriculum Plan for Year 4 – Spring Term 2023

Information texts are linked to other areas of the curriculum. We look at features of adverts, including persuasive vocabulary. advertising, persuasive vocabulary. Examination of these texts will support punctuation, composition and comprehension. Whole class reading (comprehension skills) and grammar are covered every week.
