Staff news - It's always a pleasure to give good news about teachers and I am very happy to report that Mrs Saunders is pregnant. Open evenings – These have been put on the calendar below, so please ensure that you put them in your diary. Surveys – The school always conducts its own internal surveys to ensure that we listen to views of parents, children and staff which aids school improvement and progress. This term we have been asked to conduct 3 external surveys which most of the children will be involved with.

- Growing Up in Hillingdon Survey. This is being conducted on request of the London Borough of Hillingdon to survey the health habits of children in the area. All of the children in Years 4 to 6 will have the opportunity to take part in the survey from Monday 22nd January and a letter is attached for you to find out more information.
- The Big Ambition Survey There is also a survey from the children's commissioner of England called the 'Big Ambition'. This will be conducted by Year 3 children next Tuesday. The link to see the sort of questions the children will be asked is here:

- Pro sociality in Primary School Children The final survey is from the University of Nottingham and will take place during the week beginning the 19th February and will be for a few children in Years 4 and 5. The details for this will be sent out closer to the time.

All of the surveys will not take up more than 1 lesson and are purposeful in aiding the understanding of how to improve the lives of children for the future.

Uniform – I know that children (and adults) like to show off the clothes they received for Christmas, however, I would like to remind you all that branded tracksuit trousers, branded joggers and branded leggings are not part of the school uniform.

Dogs - Thank you to everyone for respecting our rule of not allowing dogs on the playground. If you do bring your dog along to collect or drop off children, please respect that some children are scared of dogs so they should be kept on a lead at all times when you are near the school.
