Dear Parents & Carers

I hope you are well. This has been the busiest week of the school for a long time. We have had reading cafes, science workshops, class museums, netball tournaments and Ofsted. All of the staff and children have loved every minute of it. The fun and learning doesn't stop as next week we have many more exciting and interesting events.

Ofsted – I'm sure all of you are keen to learn how we got on during the recent Ofsted inspection. Unfortunately we are not allowed to share this with you until the official report is published. We have been informed that this could be by the **week beginning 21**st **March**, but may be later. This is because every Ofsted report has to go through checks before being published. I can tell you that the inspectors were very impressed by how many parents and children responded to their questionnaire and by how polite and positive parents were when the inspectors spoke to them at the school gates.

Netball Tournaments – On Monday 4th March Newnham Silvers played in the **Borough Tournament**. Throughout this competition they scored 33 goals and only conceded 4, winning very single match. In the final they beat Heathrow Primary 5 – 1 and qualified for the London Finals on Thursday 21st March. This impressive performance reflects all of the hard work the girls have put into netball this year. On Thursday 7th March Newnham Burgundy, Newnham Storm, Newnham Emerald and Newnham Midnight participated in the **Aspire Netball Rally**. All 4 teams performed brilliantly and represented the school with pride. There were no finals for this event but there was a shooting competition. Newnham Burgundies won this by scoring 12 goals in a minute and have a lovely trophy to add to our display. It is incredible that we run 5 netball teams and all of the children who have attended netball club represented the school whatever their ability. The trophies we have won so far this year show the dedication of every member of the netball squad.

Science Assembly and Workshop – I really hope that the children have told you all about this as the presenter was exceptional, demonstrating many thrilling experiments while explaining the science behind them. I would like to say a huge thank you to Mrs Horn for organising the event and to FONJSA for funding it.

Reading Cafes – We all love this annual event which helps maintain the enthusiasm the children have for reading at the school. The children and staff really appreciated all of the parents and carers who volunteered to read to small groups of children throughout the afternoons and Friday morning. Once again it shows the amazing community spirit we all share at Newnham.

Year 3 Indus Valley Class Museums - Thank you to all the parents, carers and family members that were able to attend the above events earlier this week. The pupils enjoyed carrying out roles such as greeters, cafe managers and museum guides and they did so with confidence, expertise and enthusiasm. They gained so much from this experience and they have loved hearing the positive feedback from everyone who attended their class museums.
