I hope you are well.

I would like to start this newsletter with a huge thank you to all of the FONJSA team for all of their hard work this year and particularly with last week's Family Fun Night. We also hope to send out the message that everyone is different and these differences should be celebrated.

The children really enjoyed this experience, playing 5 games, losing 1, drawing 1 and winning 3. As a head teacher, I am really proud that we are able to provide these experiences for so many children – every Year 6 child who wanted to has represented the school in sport or through participation in the choir. Alongside this we have also been successful in many events which is quite an achievement.
