## Curriculum Plan for Year 3 – Spring Term 2023

<b>English</b>	This term the children will be reading 'The Angel of Nitshill Road' by Anne Fine and through this text we will learn about how to use dialogue in a story along with how to write a playscript. Other narrative work will be based around fables and traditional stories from around the world. We will also explore poetry written by Robert Louis Stenvenson and we will practise following and writing instruction texts. Through these units of work, a range of grammar and spelling concepts will be explored and applied.

<b>Religious Education</b>	Unit Questions: Why is the Bible so important for Christians today? Why are festivals important? Throughout the year we study aspects of different religions with 50% of this work being based on Christianity. In addition, each year group studies Christmas, Harvest and Easter; focusing on a different aspect each time.	
<b>French</b>	Numbers up to 31, months of the year, items of clothing. Animals, including pets, the farm and asking the question Where?	
<b>Visits</b>	'Mr Egypt' will be visiting and working with Y3 on 03/02/23 where we will have an inspiring, educational and fun-filled day based around the Ancient Egyptians. We will be asking for a small contribution towards this visit and further details will follow next term. Pupils <b>will not</b> be required to dress up for this.	
<b>Homework</b>	Daily reading; Weekly spelling & times tables test. 30 mins Maths activity; 30 mins English activity. Homework is set on Thursdays and should be returned the following Tuesday. 3LM's Maths is set on a Wednesday and should be returned the following Monday. All children will receive a paper copy of any worksheets needed but they will also be available on the VLE in case a second copy is required or your child is absent at any time. If your child has any problems completing their homework, please tell their teacher before the homework is due.
