I would like to repeat my message I gave last term in support for the striking teachers. Your children's future may well be negatively impacted by teacher shortages due to low levels of pay in comparison to other graduate jobs, particularly in subjects like maths and science. The government offer was also rejected because the government would not directly fund the increase in wages to schools. While they are saying the rise is fully funded, this is from the extra money they have already given to schools, before the pay negotiations, to help ease current budgets and will only last until 2025.

**Borough Netball Tournament –** Well done to the girls who represented the school at the rearranged netball tournament at this school. They played brilliantly and showed an impressive sporting attitude throughout. They won 8 out of the 9 matches they played, losing 2 -1 to the eventual winners. Even in that game the girls had 8 shots compared to their 2 and the majority of play was in the opposition's half.

I really hope that the team are proud of their performance as coming 2<sup>nd</sup> out of the 52 schools is quite an achievement.

## **ESafety update- Sharing images**

More and more young children are using phones and tablets to create photos and videos and share them online or in groups on apps such as WhatsApp. Whilst this can be fun, sharing images can also be risky. It's important your child understands what's ok to share and what they should discuss with you first.

The main risks to discuss with your child are:

1) Once an image has been shared, you can never be sure who has seen it, saved it or shared it.

Newnham Junior School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare and safety of all pupils and expects all members of the school community to share this commitment.

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- 2) Personal or embarrassing pictures in the wrong hands can lead to bullying and affect a child's confidence and self-esteem.
- 3) Unwanted pictures online could affect educational and job opportunities later in life.
- 4) Sharing inappropriate images can increase the likelihood of a child receiving inappropriate contact from strangers online.
