Dear Parents & Carers

I hope you are well.

This week has flown by and the children have continued to impress by the way they have settled in. The behaviour throughout the school is amazing and when I visit classes I am so impressed with the positive learning attitudes of your children,

School Dinners – I am so pleased that every child at the school can have a free school meal and I have been happy with how the kitchen staff, children and adults have adapted to such a big change. Of course there have been a few issues which we are trying to fix. Over the coming weeks we will invite some parents into school to observe lunchtimes. This will be discussed during the FONJSA meeting next week.

Please remember to cancel any pre-ordered meals if you subsequently decide to send your child in with a packed lunch. We are seeing this happen a great deal and it is causing a lot of food wastage as The Pantry still have to cook the meal.

Uniform - The children look very smart in their uniforms and the new PE kit has made a huge difference. Next week it will be cooler so the children should be in the winter uniform, wearing named jumpers, cardigans and hoodies. Please remember that hoodies should only be worn on PE days. If you are struggling to order the new PE kit or struggling financially, please email or speak to someone at the office who will be pleased to help.

World Car free day - Friday 22nd September is World Car free day. People across communities are encouraged to get around without driving or limiting the use of cars, instead ride a train, bus, bicycle, carpool or walk. Children will be discussing the benefits of car free travel during the week. There will be a poster competition held in school and a winner selected from each class who will have their poster displayed in school to promote the day as well as receiving house points. At Newnham we have a walking map (attached to last week's newsletter) that shows parents, who need to use the car, places they can park and then walk the rest of the way.
