Curriculum Plan for Year 4 – Summer Term 2023

English	Your child will undertake a variety of reading, writing, grammar, punctuation, spelling, speaking and listening activities, based on the following genres: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Non-fiction, explanation and instruction texts - Issues and dilemmas - Poetry Examination of these texts will support the teaching of spelling, vocabulary, grammar, punctuation, composition and comprehension.
Maths	Shape – 2D symmetry, reflections Position - coordinates and translations Statistics - bar charts, line graphs and reading information in tables. Factors, multiples and prime numbers Two step word problems using all four operations and measures. Fractions - solving problems involving fractions Area and perimeter - consolidate knowledge and apply when solving problems.
Science	Electricity - looking at mains and battery appliances, how to make a circuit and what materials conduct electricity. Sound - Investigating how sounds are produced and how we hear sounds. Exploring what pitch and volume are and we can change the pitch and volume on an instrument.
Jigsaw - Relationships and health education	Relationships and changing me - the children think about different relationships we have in our lives, such as with friends and family. They think about how we can deal with loss and show others that we care. The children learn about how we change emotionally and physically as we grow older and learn about the changes that occur in puberty.
