



Curriculum Plan for Year 4 – Spring Term 2024

English	The children learn about narrative settings and audience using 'King Kong' and 'Podkin one ear' as the key texts. Poetry, including pieces from different cultures. Information texts are linked to other areas of the curriculum. We look at features of adverts, including persuasive vocabulary. advertising, persuasive vocabulary. Examination of these texts will support punctuation, composition and comprehension. Whole class reading (comprehension skills) and grammar are covered every week.
