## Curriculum Plan for Year 3 – Autumn Term 2021

<b>English</b>	This term, Year 3 children will be studying stories with different settings, poetry, plays, non-fiction books and how to use thesauruses and dictionaries. Examination of these texts will support the teaching of spelling, vocabulary, grammar, punctuation, composition and comprehension.	
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>Number</b> 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x & 10x Tables Place Value – 3 digit numbers Mental and formal written methods for Addition and Subtraction Multiply by 10 and 100 Formal written multiplication	<b>Other Areas</b> 2D Shapes Quarter turns and half turns Centimetres and millimetres Money including pounds and pence Tallying, tables of information, Pictograms Time – ¼ past, ½ past, ¼ to, 5 minute intervals Analogue and digital. Fractions, including tenths
<b>Science</b>	Food and Our Bodies; Opposites Attract (magnets)	
<b>DT</b>	Children will learn sewing skills and then design and make a purse.	
<b>Computing</b>	'We are Safe Online'; We are Connected' – consider different digital devices and how they are connected to the Internet.	
<b>History</b>	Prehistoric Britain (The Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages)	
<b>Geography</b>	The World – continents and countries.	
<b>Art</b>	The children will explore and produce patterns, lines and colour influenced by the work of Bridget Riley, using pencil and paint.	
<b>R.H.E.</b>	Being me in my world - Thinking about our place in our communities. Celebrating differences - treating others as we would like to be treated and being proud of our differences.	
<b>PE</b>	<b>3KM Wednesday &amp; Thursday; 3S Wednesday &amp; Friday; 3W Wednesday &amp; Friday</b> Dance: Magnets & Mechanisms. Games: Multi-skills & Ball skills	
<b>Music</b>	Zimbabwe - exploring the <i>mbira</i> and improvising in small ensembles Nativity - singing in tune and learning lyrics	
<b>Religious Education</b>	What do different people believe about God? Why is the Bible so important for Christians? Throughout the year we study aspects of different religions with 50% of this work being based on Christianity. In addition each year group studies Christmas, Harvest and Easter; focusing on a different aspect each time.	
<b>French</b>	Numbers 0-6, greetings, responding to classroom phrases, some colours, the alphabet.	
<b>Visits</b>	Chiltern Open Air Museum – Wednesday 20th October	
<b>Homework</b>	<b>Daily reading; Weekly spelling &amp; times tables test. 30mins Maths activity; 30mins English activity. Frog will be used once the children have been set up with their required details. All homework will then be available on Frog from 4pm on the day it is set (<a href="https://newnham-hillingdon.frogos.net/app/login">https://newnham-hillingdon.frogos.net/app/login</a>) and can be accessed using their pupil username &amp; password. All children will receive a paper copy of any worksheets needed but they will also be available on Frog.</b>
