<b>Homework</b>	All homework will be available on Google classroom from 4pm on the day it is set using the pupil username & password. A combination of spellings, tables, 10 minutes daily reading (teachers will be regularly checking for at least 5 logged adult reads on Boomreader ) plus a piece of Maths and an English activity will be set each week. Occasionally, alternative topic tasks may be set to replace English.
