Dear Parents & Carers.

As you have all been made aware the school will be affected by the industrial action on Wednesday 1st February. Today we sent out an email detailing which classes would not be attending school and which classes would. Unfortunately we have confused parents who have more than one child at the school. To clarify 4CH, 4UW, 4S and 6A will be closed due to industrial action. I am sorry for the confusion this has caused.

I am very aware that this industrial action may cause disruption amongst families and I hope that it does not adversely affect the excellent relationship we have with you. However, I would like to voice my full support for those teachers who are taking this action. Your children have many years left of their education and the striking teachers are trying to make things better for them. Many schools are understaffed as more teachers are leaving the profession than joining it. If pay is improved, your children are more likely to attend schools which are fully staffed. Having spoken to the teachers, I also know that they are more concerned with the underfunding of education. The government have not given extra money to schools for the 5% pay rise given to staff. This means that we have to make budget cuts to equipment, resources, professional development and school maintenance.

Young Voices at the 02 - Friday 20th January - I think our Year 6 pupils have finally come back down to earth after a thrilling concert, singing alongside 8000 school children at the 02. We hope that the memories made will be forever lodged in their minds and that they burst into dance every time 'Le Freak' comes on the radio! Thank you to all those families who supported the children throughout the project.

Boom Reader announced the launch of a new version of their parent app on Monday 20th January 2023. It now includes the following two new features:

- 1) Likes teachers will be able to like any comments you have written when you log reading with your child (there will be a small red heart next to the comment).
- 2) Seen by parents will be able to see when a teacher has seen their reading log (there will be a small green eye icon next to the log). They have also updated their parent information poster please see attached.

Spring Term Parents and Carers Meetings - As previously advised, we are holding the following meetings to discuss your child's progress (see below). There will be a questionnaire to fill in afterwards which can be obtained by scanning the QR codes in the building.

However, please note that these meetings must start and finish on time and therefore you must ensure you are at the classroom at your allotted time.
