It's been a lovely week seeing the children playing on the field at break times. The time they have outside is so important for their learning and your children are really lucky to have so many activities to choose from during their breaks.

Girls' Cricket – Yesterday afternoon, two teams participated in the Borough Girls' Cricket Tournament at Harefield Cricket Club. The B team won both of their games in their section, finishing top. The A team also won both of their games to progress to the final where they played Deanesfield. The final was very close but the Newnham girls' high quality bowling made the difference, taking 5 wickets and eventually winning. We were really proud to see so many of our girls participating in this competition and everyone one of them worked really hard to improve their cricket skills, showing a dedication to make progress.

E-Safety- Body image and Self esteem - Firstly, it is important that we remind parents that sites such as TikTok and YouTube have age restrictions and should only be used by children if they are being supervised. Secondly, it is important to keep an eye on the content which your child is seeing. These sites show unrealistic body types, use filters to alter appearance, some promote self-harm, anorexia and bulimia and are heavily focused on receiving 'likes'. Dr Linda Papadopoulos says parents and carers can play a key role in supporting children in this. Encourage them to reflect on their online activities and think critically about what they see. Help them ask questions like "is this how someone really looks," "why is this image being used" and "how are these images making me feel?"
