Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope you are well.

It has been a very busy week with the children working hard to make progress in all subjects.

Uniform - We have been advised by Mapac that to guarantee delivery for the Autumn term you need to place an order by 30th June. We now have samples in the school office if you need to try them before ordering. Our new supplier is Mapac and the website is ready to accept orders. Please note that the tie, PE T shirt and Hoodie are the only items that need to be purchased from this site. All other items can still be bought from supermarkets and chain stores.

I wrote in the last newsletter about children wearing the wrong trainers. Unfortunately there is still a very small amount of children coming into school wearing shoes which do not conform to our uniform policy and no note to suggest the reason for this. As most these trainers are branded, I presume this is not a financial choice. From Monday, any child wearing incorrect uniform without a letter of explanation or email from home will be missing some of their break time. Reasons for wearing uniform were noted in the last newsletter but I also believe it is unfair to the vast majority of children and parents who conform to the uniform policy, to see children walking around in Nike or Adidas shoes which do not conform to our policy. If you are unsure of our policy on shoes and trainers please refer to the uniform policy which can be found on the school's website.

Cricket - On a more positive note the boys' team took part in the Borough Tournament on Wednesday 7th June. They played 3 group games where they hit a lot of fours and sixes and took many wickets, scoring over 100 runs in each game. Due to their superior run rate, they progressed to the final where they beat Deanesfield. There were many amazing individual performances, but as a team they were exceptional.

Due to their victory in their Borough Tournament before half term, the girls' team represented Hillingdon in the London School Games Finals, playing against the top teams from each London Borough. Like the boys, they progressed as winners through the group stage, scoring an average of 128 runs per game. Unfortunately they met a very strong team in the quarter finals and despite some excellent bowling, they were knocked out. Once again the team performed brilliantly and finishing 8th place in London is quite an achievement
