## SPRING TERM CLUBS 2024 RUN BY NEWNHAM JUNIOR SCHOOL STAFF

Unless specified otherwise, all clubs detailed below start w/c 8<sup>th</sup> January and end w/c 18<sup>th</sup> March and incur a £1 charge to cover administration costs. If you wish to apply for a club run by an external provider (excluding PSD), you need to apply directly to the club provider using the details shown on the attached flyer. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding, please advise the external club provider and they will arrange for the payment to be reduced by 50%. PSD clubs are bookable via the Gateway and if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding, we will refund 50% via the Gateway after you have paid for the club in full.

### MONDAY

- **Mindful Time Club** - Ms Curtis will be running this club on Mondays after school for Year 3 & 4 from 3.15pm to 4.00pm. Children will take part in activities including drawing, colouring, Lego or origami. Children will be given time to focus on activities, listen to relaxing music and be in the moment!
- **Netball club** - Mr Wilkey, Miss Barnes and Mrs Nahal will run the netball club for Year 6 after school on Mondays from 3.15pm to 4.15pm. **Existing members only.**

### MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY

**Music Clubs** - Mrs S Wood will be running the following clubs:

- **Lower School Choir - Year 3/4** – Monday 10am Existing members need not reapply (notify the school office if your child no longer wishes to continue)
- **Upper School Choir - Year 5/6** - Wednesday 10am Existing members need not reapply (notify the school office if your child no longer wishes to continue)
